<u>Ads</u>

Jetpack Ads is a one-click feature designed to help you generate income from your WordPress site. Jetpack Ads is powered by <u>WordAds</u> — the unique ad program from WordPress.com. WordAds is the leading advertising optimization platform for WordPress sites, where the internet's top ad suppliers bid against each other to deliver their ads to your site, maximizing your revenue. Beyond providing high-quality ads, WordAds determines the best placements to guarantee the highest revenue and most reliable compatibility across most WordPress themes.

Jetpack Ads is available to anyone with Jetpack Premium or Professional plans — no approval process required. When you activate this feature, you'll see ads on your site right away and can tweak ad placement settings and view earnings on WordPress.com.

Comments

When someone reads an article on your site and wants to comment, they can now use one of their existing social networking accounts to post a comment without having to create yet another account and profile.

Contact Form

Jetpack's Contact Form allows you to add a contact form to any post or page. When someone contacts you through the form, you receive an email notification for each contact form response. Plus, each message is listed in the Feedback section of your WordPress Admin making it easy to find and follow up with contacts. It's easy to customize both the contact form and email notifications to get the information that is relevant to you.

Custom CSS

The Custom Content Types module adds custom post types (CPTs) to your site. These CPTs allow you to add content that doesn't necessarily fit into a post, but isn't right for a static page either. Since this is part of Jetpack, you can even switch themes without losing these custom post types. This includes custom post types for portfolios, testimonials, food menus, and comics.

Enhanced Distribution

Allows your content to be included in the WordPress.com "firehose" of public blog content.

The firehose is a stream of the public data (public posts, comments, etc.) that flow through WordPress.com and Jetpack blogs that participate in Enhanced Distribution. The firehose is used by companies and people who are interested in public blog content. When these firehose users display content from your blog, they are required to link back to your blog which helps to promote your content.

Extra Sidebar Widgets

Extra widgets you can add to your blog, including RSS Links, Twitter Timelines, and Facebook Like Boxes.

The "Extra Sidebar Widgets" module includes widgets you can add to your blog. From RSS Links to Twitter Timelines and Facebook Like Boxes to social icons, this module makes it easy to add extra functionality to your site. Use widgets to display Upcoming Events and Milestones. Gravatar Hovercards

Google Analytics

Jetpack already includes <u>Site Stats</u> with reports that offer quick, at-a-glance views of the traffic on your site. New posts, likes, and comments are shown alongside visitor activity, so it's easier to make sense of the numbers.

Google Analytics adds advanced features to complement Jetpack stats. Funnel reports help you track the path visitors take through your site, and goal conversion lets you measure how visitors complete specific tasks (such as reaching a product page or contact form). If you already use Google Analytics with other projects, you'll be able to see all your stats in one place.

Google Analytics support on Jetpack is available to all users with Premium and Professional plans.

WPWebHost Infinite Scroll

Pulls the next posts automatically into view when the reader approaches the bottom of the page.

Most themes nowadays have Infinite Scroll support built in already, but if yours doesn't, you can add support to your <u>theme</u> and use <u>CSS</u> to customize the look.

JSON API

Authorizes applications and services to securely connect to your blog, and allows them to use your content or offer you new functionality.

Jetpack allows you to authorize applications and services to securely connect to your blog and let them use your content in new ways and offer you new functionality.

Lazy Loading Images

Makes pages load faster by only loading images that are on the screen, and loads other images as the user scrolls.

Lazy Loading Images makes pages load much faster by only loading visible images, waiting to load images that are offscreen as you scroll down.

In an effort to improve and optimize your site's loading time, Lazy Loading Images provides a significant benefit in page speed and bandwidth and is especially great for users in low-bandwidth or expensive-bandwidth environments, particularly for mobile users.

<u>Likes</u>

Allows readers to show their appreciation for your posts with a single click.

People really like to like things. This feature enables a "Like" area at the bottom of your posts and pages. A button allows your readers to show appreciation for your posts as well as save your posts for later viewing on WordPress.com using the Reader.

Once a user likes your post, their Gravatar will be displayed below your content, allowing you to engage with them further. You'll also receive a notification in your toolbar if you have the notifications module enabled, and an email notifying you of the action.

Markdown

Monitor

Alerts you via email if your site goes down.

Jetpack's downtime monitor keeps tabs on your site and alerts you the moment that downtime is detected. When activated, one of our servers starts checking your site every five minutes. If it looks like something's gone awry, we'll fire off an email notification to the WordPress.com account associated with your Jetpack installation.

Notifications

Receive notifications for new comments and Likes in your admin bar and on your mobile device.

Photon

Jetpack's image CDN (formerly Photon), is an image acceleration and editing service for sites hosted on WordPress.com or on Jetpack-connected WordPress sites. That means less load on your host and faster images for your readers.

Plugin Updates

Allows you to choose which plugins update automatically.

When a plugin update is released, the best practice is to update that plugin right away. What if you have multiple sites using the same plugin? You used to have to log into each site individually and to update the plugin manually from that site's dashboard. With multiple sites, this process can take quite a while.

With Jetpack's Plugin Updates, you can update plugins, set plugins to automatically update, and activate or deactivate plugins on a per-site basis or in bulk. You can also make a new post for any of your blogs from a single page without having to login and post from each site individually. Also, this new interface was designed and built to provide a great user experience whether you're on a computer, tablet, or mobile device.

Post by Email

Publish posts using any email client.

Post by Email is a way of publishing posts on your blog via email. Any email client can be used to send the email, allowing you to publish quickly and easily from anywhere.

Proofreading

Check your spelling, grammar, and written style prior to publishing.

Jetpack can check your spelling, grammar, and style using Proofreading technology. This feature uses artificial intelligence and natural language processing technology to find your writing errors and offer smart suggestions.

Protect

Protect your site from traditional and distributed brute force attacks.

Jetpack Protect allows you to protect yourself against traditional brute force attacks and distributed brute force attacks that use many servers against your site.

Jetpack's botnet security features work automatically when you install Jetpack and connect Jetpack to your WordPress.com account. With botnet protection in place via Jetpack Protect, your site will block unwanted login attempts.

You can view a count of attacks to your site with a widget in your self-hosted site's dashboard.

WPWebHost Publicize

Share new posts on social media networks automatically, or schedule future shares with custom messages.

Publicize makes it easy to share your site's posts on several social media networks automatically when you publish a new post. Premium and Professional plan users can also share content that has already been published, and schedule their posts to be shared at a specific time.

Related Posts

The Related Posts feature scans all of your posts, analyzes them, and lets you show contextual posts your visitors might be interested in reading after they're done with whatever post they're on.

Site Verification

Verify your site for use with Google, Bing, and Pinterest and their tools.

Verifying your site is not necessary for it to be indexed with Google, Bing, or any other search engine. However, various platforms allow website owners to have additional tools to help them use their sites. Among them are Google, Bing, and Pinterest. For example, Google Search Console will show you the total number of individual URLs on your site that have been indexed by Google, which search

keywords are most significant for your site, and other information about how Google is indexing your site.

Most sites require you to add a hidden "meta tag" to your page or change a DNS entry to verify your site. This can be tricky if you're not technical, but Jetpack's Site Verification module makes it easy!

<u>Sitemaps</u>

Generate a list of pages to be indexed by search engines like Google or Bing.

Sitemaps are files that list each post and page that should be indexed by search engines like Google or Bing. Jetpack allows you to generate such files thanks to the Sitemaps module. Jetpack generates two different sitemaps for you: a sitemap listing all your public posts and pages, and a News sitemap built specifically for Google News.

Spam Filtering

Automatically filter out spam comments, product reviews, or contact form submissions.

Spam Filtering lets you:

- Automatically filter comments, pingbacks, and contact form submissions for known spam.
- Review comments flagged as spam.
- View stats about spam activity on your site.
- Easily and automatically activate this feature when you install Jetpack.

Subscriptions

Allow visitors to receive notifications of your latest posts or comments.

Many visitors visit your site once and never come back. However, you can convert more of these visitors into regular readers by making it easy to subscribe to your content. Jetpack takes care of letting them know whenever you publish a new post.

With Subscriptions, visitors can choose to subscribe to new posts and/or to subscribe to stay involved in the conversation when new comments appear on a post where they've already commented.

WP.me Shortlinks

Generate short and simple links to your content using the wp.me domain.

Shortlinks are a quick way to get short and simple links to your posts and pages. They use the wp.me domain so you can have more space to write on social media sites. The functionality for these shortlinks is similar to other URL shortening services. WP.me is different, though, in a few ways:

- Every post on WordPress.com and Jetpack-powered blogs has a WP.me URL.
- Shortlinks are all exposed in the <head> using rel=shortlink.
- The links are permanent and will work as long as WordPress.com is around.
- The WP.me domain is spam-free, because we are constantly monitoring and removing spam from WordPress.com.
- Note: This feature only works for WordPress-hosted websites.

Widget Visibility

Configure widgets to appear only on specific pages.

The Widget Visibility module enables you to configure widgets to appear only on certain pages (or be hidden on certain pages) by using the Visibility panel. With this tool, you can control visibility in five ways: page type, category, tag, date, and author.

- **Notifications** opens a dropdown that displays your latest notifications, including recent likes and comments.
