MDR administered a nationwide survey and online bulletin board to K-12 teachers about technology in their schools. Survey responses and qualitative perceptions from over 4,400 teachers create a snapshot of how they are using classroom technologies, as well as the benefits and challenges. MDR's State of the K-12 Market 2018 report, **Teachers Talk Technology**, presents a summary and analysis of the findings.

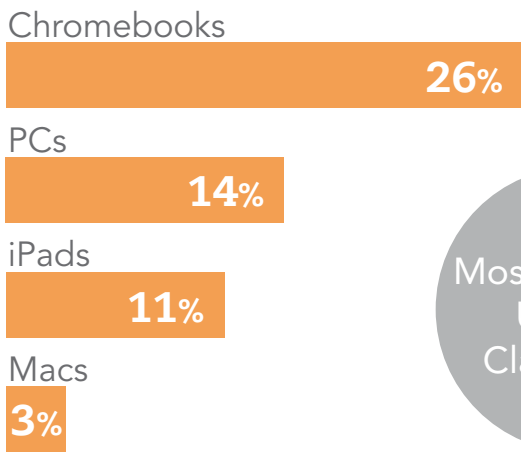
