Multiple Guinness World Record Holder

Carl Reese is an American endurance driver who has set the most transcontinental driving records than anyone since Erwin “Cannonball” Baker. Carl and his team has set ten world records to date. The most notable of these runs was the solo motorcycle “Cannonball” from Los Angeles to New York that Reese set in 38 hours, 49 minutes.
