In an effort to be open and transparent, DataFile Technologies publishes an annual *Accuracy Report* to illustrate our commitment to quality and communicate our accuracy rate, defined as total portion of records requests handled by DataFile which did not result in unauthorized disclosures. While our goal is zero errors, we are human and will make a rare mistake. **We are proud to report the DataFile accuracy rate for 2018 was 99.97%** (error rate less than four hundredths of one percent). Our single-patient breaches dropped over 80% from 2017 when we were already outperforming the national average. Our compliance track record gives customers peace of mind.

Health data breaches have become increasingly commonplace. According to data from the Department of Health and Human Services' Office for Civil Rights (OCR), practices of all sizes struggled with HIPAA compliance in 2018, racking up 351 data breaches exposing over 13 million healthcare records. That's **over 2.5 times the volume of records exposed in 2017** despite the number of breaches remaining nearly constant.
