Join Us March 28-30, 2019 in San Francisco for "Forty Years & More: International

Conference on Iranian Diaspora Studies" for keynote addresses, panel discussions, and two major exhibitions of Iranian diaspora art in the city of San Francisco.

The conference will mark the anniversary of the 1979 Iranian Revolution by understanding the ways that Iranians as exiles, immigrants, and as second and third-generation hyphenated citizens of their respective nations, have met with both challenges and opportunities of diaspora experience. Conference presentations in the arts, humanities, and social sciences will share new scholarship and research about the Iranian diaspora from a variety of perspectives and national contexts.

As part of its mission, the Center emphasizes interdisciplinary and transnational scholarship, research, and teaching about the Iranian diasporic experience.

The Center for Iranian Diaspora Studies fosters innovative and collaborative scholarship between faculty and students interested in the culture and history of Iranian diaspora and engages with complex and pressing subjects such as nationalism, immigration, xenophobia, assimilation, gender, and identity.

The Center's research, programming, and projects examine conventional narratives, advocate for new forms of scholarly engagement, and enable opportunities for collaboration among

academics, artists, and activists, seeking new ways of understanding the present through the critical examination of the past.

ABOUT THE CENTER

The Center prepares a new generation of policy makers, business leaders, artists and cultural ambassadors to effectively understand and engage with people of Iranian heritage. The Center serves as a unique and valuable academic and cultural resource providing an innovative approach to the study of and research about Iranian diasporas and their impact on the Iranian identity.

The Center also models new methods of research and knowledge distribution that emphasize:

- exposure to students through public lectures;
- the development of collaborative opportunities for faculty and students across San Francisco State's colleges to engage in research, scholarship and service about Iranian Diaspora communities globally; and,
- a platform for academic programs (lectures, film-screenings, music and other cultural events) that fosters intellectual engagement and conversation with local and international communities.

ABOUT THE LEADERSHIP

Dr. Persis Karim is the Neda Nobari Chair of the newly-established Center for Iranian Diaspora Studies and a professor in the Comparative and World Literature department at SF State.

Karim received her Ph.D. in Comparative Literature and master's degree in Middle Eastern Studies from the University of Texas at Austin. From 1999-2017, she was a professor in the Department of English and Comparative Literature at San Jose State University, where she taught courses in English, American literature, world literature, ethnic literature, creative writing and Middle Eastern studies. She coordinated the Middle Eastern Studies minor program from 2010-2017 and was the founding director of the Persian Studies Program.

Karim is the editor/co-editor of three anthologies of Iranian diaspora literature: *Tremors: New Fiction by Iranian American Writers* (2013); *Let Me Tell You Where I've Been: New Writing by Women of the Iranian Diaspora* (2006), and *A World Between: Poems, Short Stories and Essays by Iranian-Americans* (1999). She has written numerous articles on modern Iranian literature and Iranian diaspora literature for journals such as *Iranian Studies, Comparative Studies of South Asia, Africa, and the Middle East, and MELUS: Multi-Ethnic Literatures of the United States.* She is also a published poet.
