Awards Offered

- Y Sustainability Leadership Award

 Awarded to an organization within a specific industry whose actions over the last 12 months prove sustainability is a core business objective.
- Y Sustainability Initiative of the Year Awarded to an organization within a specific industry that launched or completed a sustainability initiative or project within the last 12 months.
- ▼ Sustainability Product of the Year

 Awarded to an organization within a specific industry that launched or completed a physical product within the last 12 months that improves sustainability or is designed to be more eco-friendly than market alternatives.

- Y Sustainability Service of the Year

 Awarded to an organization within a specific industry that launched or completed a service within the last 12 months that improves sustainability or is designed to be more eco-friendly than market alternatives.
- Sustainability Hero (Executive)

 Awarded to an executive individual within an organization whose efforts over the past 12 months have improved the sustainability initiatives of the organization. Executives include all chief-level, vice president-level or similar titles.
- Sustainability Champion (Nonexecutive)

 Awarded to a non-executive individual within an organization whose efforts over the past 12 months have improved the sustainability initiatives of the organization. All employee levels under vice president are eligible.



How to Qualify for NGO or Nonprofit Status

NGOs, nonprofit and charity organizations may enter one nomination free of charge. The entry discount applies to those working in environmental or sustainability spaces wherein all proceeds are diverted back into activities that further the organizations' agenda. Charitable arms of commercial organizations are not eligible.

Nominations must be submitted by the organizations themselves and not by a public relations or other agency.



Submitting Your Nomination

NOMINATION PROCESS

Submitting your nomination is a simple 3 step process:

- 1. Download the nomination guide
- 2. Draft and proofread your nomination
- Click the "NOMINATE NOW" button at bintelligence.com to submit your nomination

All nominations are 100% confidential. Neither the nomination nor any of its content will be shared with anyone other than our staff and judges.

You may submit multiple nominations in multiple categories as a means of increasing your odds of winning.

NOMINATION FEES

Entry fees are collected when your nomination is submitted online. The Business Intelligence Group accepts all major credit cards, bank transfers and checks.

All credit card transactions are certified to PCI Service Provider Level 1, the most stringent level of certification.

- Maximum of 250 words. When possible provide quantifiable results.

Provide a link to a transparent PNG of the nominee logo.

JUDGING PROCESS

ADDITONAL EXPOSURE

While an executive is not able to judge his or her own award category or those of his or her peers, we strongly encourage business experts to become judges.

Judges are asked to score nominations and to share meaningful feedback with nominated candidates.

Business leaders with experience, insight and knowledge are sought to be part of the volunteer panel of independent experts. Judging nominations is easy and usually only requires an hour of two of time.
