THE NEW IMPROVED HELP 'EM UP® HARNESS

And the Latest in our line of Walking Accessories: New Loop Handles

Features of the new improved Help 'Em Up Harness:

"D" Ring Connectors at 6 different contact points (neck/chest/hips) that will allow for clip-on devices – such as strap connections for use in water treadmills, to connect into wheel chairs, and also to connect our new Loop Handle Walking Accessories! These D-Rings allow for increased stability and balance using the harness in these devices and while walking. They also come in handy for attaching rehab tools such as thera-bands for exercise therapy and anti-knuckling devices. (Note: connector clips with d-rings will be available to retrofit earlier models of the harness with this feature so you can use as described above.)

New Conventional Hip-lift — we combined the belly band and pelvic pad into one piece that is more ergonomically designed and sits farther back under the pelvic floor. As a result, we are also finding that the conventional hip-lift can be used on more male dogs(!) as it sits farther back behind their penis to provide clearance for them to urinate.

New Connector Strap featuring "comfort flex" – we have added some elastic "flex" to our connector strap connecting the rear hip-lift to the front shoulder harness. This allows it to "give" more while the dog sits or lays in the harness providing greater ease and comfort.

Larger Handles on the Rear Hip Lift – on the larger sized harnesses, we have made the handles larger for lifting durability of the hind-quarters. We have also reinforced stitching to accommodate a future seat belt accessory for use of the harness in cars. This will allow the whole dog to be secure (not just the chest).

The latest in our line of Walking Accessories:

Loop Handles, the newest in our line of walking accessories, come in sets in 2 sizes: XS/S/M and L/XL to use based on the size of the harness. Custom to attach to the new D-ring connectors on the harness, they are soft, flexible and easily adjustable to help you add some extra support or leverage when lifting or walking the dog with the harness on. They act like a sling and can be positioned in a variety of ways — vertically from front to back supporting the whole body, or horizontally from side-to-side supporting the front shoulders or rear hips. We find these less bulky than our other walking accessories and easy to use.
