Eboni K. Williams To Host & Executive Produce 'REVOLT BLACK NEWS'

Williams plans to bring fresh analysis to headlines at critical time

New York, NY — Attorney and TV personality, Eboni K. Williams, has signed on to serve as Host and Executive Producer of 'REVOLT BLACK NEWS'. In a media alert on Tuesday, REVOLT announced Williams will permanently host 'REVOLT BLACK NEWS' twice weekly on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 9 p.m. EST/6 p.m. PST, starting on June 9, 2020. Williams' undergraduate degree is in African-American studies from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill.

"My legal experience, newsroom experience, and understanding of the issues uniquely positions me for this role. I'm excited to help REVOLT elevate the dialogue and keep our audience educated and informed." said Williams.
