### LEAVING LEARNING TO CHANCE



Only 1 in 3 school districts expected teachers to provide instruction, track engagement, or monitor progress for students March - May.

### ACHIEVEMENT GAPS ARE WIDENING



The average student may lose 7 months of learning, with students of color & low-income students losing up to a year — widening existing achievement gaps by 15-20%.

## STRUGGLING TO PLAN NEXT YEAR



As of early June, less than 25% of school districts have named a process or timeline for developing 2020-21 fall reopening plans.
