The AGF API has been designed based on feedback from its data customers who are looking to bring more transparency and accuracy to their end products. This new API will give these companies the ability to calculate tax rates, taxable value calculations, local flat taxes, and registration fees, at a more granular level that mirror DMV receipts.

"ATC leads the in-state and out-of-state titling and registration services industry," said Damon Bennett, VP, Business Development for ATC. "And with the ATC Granular Fees API, we're able to drill down to the most granular level of registration fees and taxes, so our customers can have the most accurate information possible. The ATC Granular Fees API allows:

- Allows users to dynamically pick the granular level of fees in API response. AGF can return over a hundred fees in specific jurisdictions, broken down to the individual fee or rolled-up into a single number, depending on the users' preferences.
- Includes important notes such as reminders on differences to be seen in specific locations. For example, these notes can be important information such as qualifications to receive military waivers and discounts in particular jurisdictions.

"We've come a long way from the time when every town had a car dealership," Bennett said, "And all you could buy is what they had on the lot. Now, customers have the ability to find the exact car they want, whether it is 2 miles away, or 802 miles away. Technology like ours makes that possible and we intend to always be the leader in title and registration data for all 50 states."
