What is a Micro-Business?

Micro-businesses (a business that operates on a very small scale) comprise almost 90% of the nation's businesses and represent an even higher proportion of businesses in low-wealth communities. (Dun & Bradstreet Data)

Micro-Businesses Impact Communities

Micro-businesses in underserved communities grow and hire when they have access to resources. Employment from micro-businesses in low-wealth communities alone could grow by well over 10% with assistance and technical support.
