The grants, which range from \$100 to \$500 are available to any person with intellectual or developmental disabilities with a new or emerging business. The requirements for application are:

- Applicant must be 16 years of age or older
- The business must be a new or emerging business that has not generated more than \$3,000 in revenue
- Funds can be used for supplies, equipment, training, marketing, or anything else needed to start a business
- Businesses ideas must conform to legal requirements and not fall within disallowed categories.

Once an individual has been approved for a grant there are stipulations prior to disbursement, including:

- Approved applicants must complete a free course on business finances and budgeting from Celebrate EDU
- Approved applicants must submit a business budget and track spending of their funds.
