
# DIABETES ACCESS PILOT INITIATIVE 2021

## INTRODUCTION

NOVA ScriptsCentral is focused on helping to improve the health of people diagnosed with diabetes in Virginia.

## STATISTICS

According to the Virginia Department of Health 2,153,733 Virginians, more than 1 out of 3 have prediabetes. Another 631,194 Virginians have diabetes which is about 1 out of every 11 people.

#### INITITATIVE


NOVA ScriptsCentral will provide insulin for free to uninsured patients being treated at one of its 16 safety net partner clinics in Northern Virginia. These patients will also have access to affordable diabetic testing supplies.



Insulin: \$0

Diabetes Testing Supplies: \$10

(1 box of 50 count test strips & 1 of box 100 lancets)





Chronic Disease Medicines for Diabetes Management: \$5 per medicine

## SOME FACTS

- According to a GoodRx analysis, for the average insulin patient who has insurance, the price of living with diabetes can exceed \$4,800 per year.
- Diabetes patients who don't have insurance can spend an additional \$1,300 in annual expenses just to control their diabetes.
- Average Retail Price for 30-Day
  Supply of all insulins is \$476

#### ADDITIONAL DETAILS

- There will be 5 different types of Eli Lilly insulin available. (Rapid Acting, Short Acting, Intermediate Acting, Long Acting and Premixed Insulin)
- Both insulin vials and insulin pens will be available through this program.
- Eligible patients can receive up to 30 90 day supply of insulin for free.
- NOVA ScriptsCentral can provide medicines to manage high blood pressure, high cholesterol and other chronic diseases for \$5.
