Through its signature program, Wendy's Wonderful Kids, the Dave Thomas Foundation for Adoption-Canada provides funding to adoption agencies to support the hiring of recruiters who implement an evidence-based, child-focused recruitment model. According to a five-year evaluation in the United States, the model is up to three times more effective at serving children who have been in foster care the longest, including older youth, sibling groups and children with special needs.

To date, Wendy's Wonderful Kids recruiters in Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, Newfoundland, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Saskatchewan and Ontario have found adoptive homes for 445 children, with another 75 in their pre-adoptive placements.

John earned a Diploma in Procurement and Supply Chain Management from the Ontario Institute of Supply Chain Canada, a B.A. Honours Degree from Trent University, and is pursuing his EMBA in Global Leadership from the University of Fredericton.
