Description of Injury:

Claimant suffered abrasions to his forehead from kicks to his head, right cheek, bilateral knees, fracture to his right upper arm, multiple facial abrasions/lacerations, and emotional distress.

Where Injury Occurred:

1436 Valencia Avenue, San Bernardino, CA 92404

Act Causing the Injury & Dangerous Condition & How Did Injury Occur:

Sgt. Imran Ahmed, Officer Kevin Ramirez (Badge # 51245), Officer Paulina Zamora (Badge # 51282), and Officer Joe Lucero (Badge # 51153) of the San Bernardino Police Department, and others, acted while in the course and scope of their employment and under color of authority as police officers for the City of San Bernardino. Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed acted with excessive force as the Claimant was in a submissive position, kneeling

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on the ground, face down, with arms outstretched behind him, and had surrendered to officers when officers first made contact with Claimant at 1436 Valencia Avenue.

Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed, City of San Bernardino and its employees, violated the Claimant's civil rights and constitutional rights, including unlawful search and seizure. Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed attempted to cover-up and suppress the truth surrounding the subject incident by filing false police reports and attempting to cover the video evidence at the time of the assault and battery on Claimant. Additionally, Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed threatened Claimant while at the scene, prior to being treated by San Bernardino County Fire personnel, and at Arrowhead Regional Medical Center on the day of the incident. Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed told Claimant to misstate the true facts about how Claimant fractured his right humerus and coerced him into making a false statement on video in an effort to cover-up the beating and fracture that Claimant suffered at the hands of Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed. Video evidence clearly shows that Officers Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed filed false reports and in fact caused the injuries to Claimant, who was not resisting and submissive, kneeling down, head down, with his arms outstretched behind his back when officers arrived to make contact with Claimant.

Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed of the San Bernardino Police Department, while in the course and scope of their employment as police officers for the City of SAN BERNARDINO, acted with excessive force when they made or caused to be made unlawful contact with Claimant's person without justification. Sgt. Imran Ahmed, Kevin Ramirez, Paulina Zamora and Joe Lucero kicked and punched Claimant multiple times, and

violently twisted Claimant's right arm, causing Claimant's right humerus to be fractured (See attached x-ray images from the date of the incident taken at Arrowhead Regional Medical Center). Claimant, JOSE GARIBO, was struck multiple times by officers Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed without justification, causing Claimant's right humerus fracture, which required surgical open internal fixation. Sgt. Ahmed, Officer Ramirez, Officer Zamora and Officer Lucero of the San Bernardino Police Department, and others employed by the SAN BERNARDINO Police Department, acted unreasonably in light of the facts and circumstances surrounding their contact with Claimant on April 18, 2021.

Sgt. Imran Ahmed, a commanding officer, further falsified use of force reports and fraudulently manipulated and coerced Claimant to misstate the true nature of his injuries and how he suffered his injuries.

The City of SAN BERNARDINO and its employees, including Officers Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed of the San Bernardino Police Department violated the Claimant's civil rights and constitutional rights, including unlawful search and seizure.

Claimant is informed and believes and thereon alleges that the City of SAN BERNARDINO and its employees, including Officers Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed of the San Bernardino Police Department also discriminated against Claimant, as a Hispanic youth. The City of SAN BERNARDINO knowingly and deliberately fostered, maintained and condoned a policy, practice and custom or otherwise acted in a manner that was deliberately indifferent to the lives and liberty of persons, such as JOSE GARIBO, and that such policy, practice, custom and/or actions were a direct and legal cause of his injuries. The policy, practice, custom, and actions included, without limitation, knowingly and deliberately failing to properly train, discipline and supervise

employees regarding both the use of force, including deadly force, and the proper procedures to be followed in detaining individuals.

At the time of the violence inflicted on JOSE GARIBO by officers Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed of the San Bernardino Police Department, the City of SAN BERNARDINO Police Department had in place, and had ratified, policies, procedures, customs and practices which permitted and encouraged their police officers to unjustifiably, unreasonably and in violation of the Fourth and Fourteenth Amendments, use violence against individuals being detained. Said policies, procedures, customs and practices also called for the City of SAN BERNARDINO not to discipline, prosecute or in any way take corrective or responsive action to known incidents and/or complaints of unjustified use of force and violent acts by said officers or the related claims and lawsuits resulting from such violence.

Said policies, procedures, customs and practices called for the refusal of the City of SAN BERNARDINO to investigate or document complaints of previous incidents of unjustified violence and, instead, officially claim that such incidents were justified and proper.

The City of SAN BERNARDINO's policies, procedures, customs and practices of inaction and cover-up encouraged officers of SAN BERNARDINO Police Department, including Officers Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed of the San Bernardino Police Department, to believe that unjustified beatings, violence, and deadly force against individuals being detained was permissible, in particular against individuals of minority groups, such as JOSE GARIBO.

CLAIMS ASSERTED:

Claimant, JOSE GARIBO, asserts the following State claims against the City of San Bernardino and its officers Kevin Ramirez, Joe Lucero, Paulina Zamora and Sgt. Imran Ahmed:

Assault & Battery

Negligence

False Arrest

Fraud Based on False Police Reporting

Bane Act Violations, based on coercion and intimidation.
