Kids Adventure Games is a multi-discipline adventure race for kids.

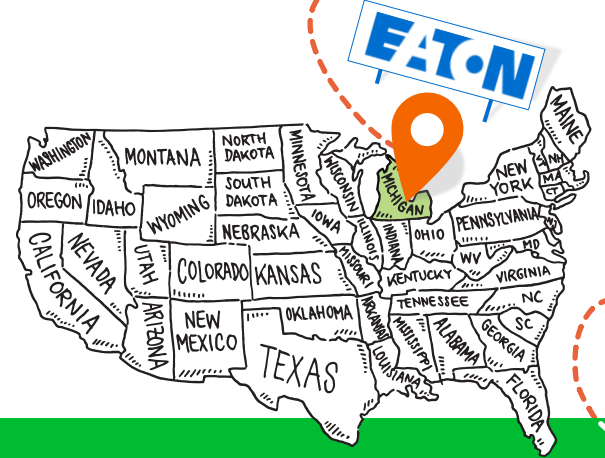
Participants compete in teams through an outdoor course featuring man-made and natural obstacles.
