Ready to get the ball rolling with becoming a dog-friendly office? All you have to do is:

- Determine interest by conducting a survey Once you've decided your workplace is a good fit for four-legged friends, send out an anonymous survey to determine employee interest, concerns, or opinions on the program.
- **Establish a Dogs at Work Committee -** The committee will oversee the program, review dog applications, and ensure the office is dog-friendly.
- **Get landlord approval** Provide your landlord with information about the program and the rules and guidelines your office is implementing to maintain a safe and clean workplace.
- Pet proof the building Tuck cords out of the way, set up water bowls, designate dog-friendly areas, and put up approved Dog ID signs as you get ready to welcome your new four-legged coworkers.
- **Provide interested employees with Employee Handbook** Ready to bring dogs into the office? Have employees familiarize themselves with the rules and expectations of bringing their dog in and fill out the necessary paperwork.
