

## **Industry Veteran Scott McCausland Joins Dacier Technologies as CEO**

MVP experienced tremendous revenue growth during Scott's tenure, as the company's customer base expanded to almost one thousand organizations. In November 2018, Scott sold MVP Systems to Help Systems, a private equity backed software company. He stayed on as General Manager of Workload Automation Solutions until 2020.

Prior to MVP, Scott was the EVP Sales and one of two shareholders of a privately held software company that specialized in application monitoring. Scott led the company from its infancy in 1991 until 2007, at which time the company had more than 150 people in eleven offices. In 2007, Scott sold his stake in the company.

Scott stated "I am excited to help launch Dacier Technologies. From the conversations I have had with early adopters of the platform, Dacier solves critical issues that have been plaguing developers for years.
