These studies offer a way for almost anyone — regardless of age, ethnicity, or background — to help move science forward. Eligible participants usually receive compensation for study-related time and travel.

Meridian now has 38 sites nationwide. The site will be Meridian's third in Virginia and follows the company's opening of a family medicine research clinic in Portsmouth last year.

Meridian was founded in 1999 and has enrolled more than 85,000 participants into clinical trials since its inception.
