Themes include: Mental health, suicide, and family dysfunction.


AUTHOR NOTE

A few years ago, I was back home in Australia doing a book signing for my debut YA/Fantasy when a friend told me a heartbreaking story. A year earlier, her ex died by suicide and she was left with three daughters, ages 11-15. She told me that the hardest part is when her daughters ask, "Mummy, why did Daddy do it?" because she has no idea what to say. My heart caved. My dad died by suicide when I was 13 and all I could think was, "If anyone can help speak to this, I could."

My goal with this book is not to give an answer as to the "why." When it comes to something like this, no one can. I want to offer children and parents a language where they feel comfortable talking about feelings that often get buried because no one knows how to even begin the conversation.


