Founded in 2006 by Kuldip Verma, Vermaland offers land options for residential, commercial, agricultural, industrial, solar farms and other renewable projects. The company currently owns more than 25,000 acres of land, which is the largest holdings of 50 to 1,200-acre parcels in Metro Phoenix.

Vermaland currently oversees development contracts on 16 solar farm sites with several solar power developers, totaling more than 10,000 acres. After current pending projects are completed, it is estimated that approximately an additional 2,000 megawatts of electrical power will be produced from their facilities alone. The company strives to advocate for solar living by bringing several large renewable companies to the City of Phoenix from around the world.

Vermaland remains a private sector leader in advocacy for solar and other renewable energy projects. Their mission allows the City of Phoenix to have an ally in attaining our goal of being the world's most sustainable desert city.
